Bananas over Books is an exciting literacy day camp held at our school. The campers embark on daily adventures using books to guide their imaginations through learning and fun! Camps begin July 12 and end August 20 with morning or afternoon sessions. Bananas over Books is open to all students entering a regular Grade 2 through 7 program in the fall of 2010. The program requires each student to have a minimum grade one reading level as determined by current school programming. The camp is designed to foster the enjoyment of reading and to help your child to further develop his or her literacy skills through a wide range of enriching, fun filled activities. We are very excited to have Keeley Mokelky, Kaley Woodman and Michael Cherry as our leaders this summer! The cost for each child is \$4.00 per session if you register before June 14 and \$5.00 per session after June 14. Registrations are first come, first serve, therefore encourage your children to register early!
