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Background

The Division supports the provision of an English As An Additional Language Program for students requiring assistance with the acquisition of basic English language skills. English as an Additional Language (EAL) programming is designed to provide specialized service for students who require assistance in acquiring an English language foundation.

Procedures

1. English as an Additional Language programming will be offered in all schools.
2. Intake of EAL students is outlined in AP212-1.
3. Eligibility for the program shall be determined by a student's English language proficiency as outlined in AP 212-1.
4. The program may vary in length and intensity depending on the student's needs.
5. The program shall follow the policies, guidelines and procedures established by the Ministry.
