## **APPRENTICESHIP**

Learning the skills of a trade through an apprenticeship is a valuable learning experience that can contribute to the lifelong learning and development of students to help them become engaged and contributing citizens. Granting of credit for approved apprenticeships recognizes student achievement in trades outside of the regular Secondary Level Program.

## **APPRENTICESHIP CREDITS**

At Holy Rosary High School, the following apprenticeship credits are available:

- Apprenticeship A20
- Apprenticeship B20
- Apprenticeship A30
- Apprenticeship B30

## **APPRENTICESHIP CREDITS PROCESS:**

- 1. Holy Rosary High School Career Center oversees the process.
- 2. The student must secure employment with an approved journeyperson.
- 3. Apprenticeship credits may be used to meet the Practical and Applied Arts/Arts Education or as electives to meet the 24-credit requirement at the Secondary Level. To meet the credit requirements for graduation, students employed in a trade in which the hours worked are eligible for apprenticeship credit may earn up to four credits. One credit for every 100 hours of trade experience.
- 4. Only students who are registered at Holy Rosary High School and are working (employed) in a trade are eligible for Apprenticeship credits.
- 5. The student will be required to complete the proper paperwork.

If students are interested in obtaining Apprenticeship credits, they are asked to meet with a Career Counsellor to get the process started.
