SASKATCHEWAN YOUTH APPRENTICESHIP PROGRAM (SYA)

This is an optional high school program that raises awareness of apprenticeship in Saskatchewan schools by helping young people discover the rewards that come with working in the skilled trades. SYA enhances student career development by exploring the world of opportunities skilled trades offer.

PROGRAM BENEFITS

Get a head start on career planning

Record achievements for resumes and career portfolios

Students who have completed all three levels (Level 1,2,3) and register as an apprentice in Saskatchewan in a designated trade within five years receive:

- Waiver of Saskatchewan Apprenticeship registration fee (currently \$150).
- No charge for first level of technical training tuition.
- 300 hours of trade time credit (100 hours for each level).

SYA Process:

- 1. Holy Rosary High School Career Center oversees the process.
- 2. This program is available to students in grade 10, 11, 12.
- 3. The student will be required to complete the proper paperwork, passport, portfolio.
- 4. If students are interested in the Saskatchewan Youth Apprenticeship program, they are asked to meet with a Career Counsellor to get the process started.
